- Items to be dry & as empty as possible.
- Recycle kerbside if possible.
- Please be respectful and don't drop off items we don't take.

01 Hair Care

- tubes, pumps, lids
- hair dye containers, equipment, gloves
- packaging from hair care / colour items
- hair care aerosols

*hair care containers, tubes, pumps and equipment to be emptied & rinsed 3 times



02 Dental

- manual toothbrushes
- electric toothbrush heads
- toothpaste tubes & lids
- floss containers & inter-dental brushes
- dental packaging



03 Dish & Air Care

- lids, sprays, bottle tops
- air-fresheners (plug-in, car etc)
- air-freshener aerosols
- dish & air care packaging



04 Skin Care

- bottles, tubes, pumps, lids
- droppers, sprays
- skin care packaging



05 Razors

- disposable & refillable
- replacement cartridges
- packaging

*razors & blades must be dropped to the office and not left on the stand.



06 Other Items

- flat plastic lids (smaller than 5cm inserts removed)
- plastic bread tags
- household batteries



Please Consider

Reuse is better than recycle- can you repurpose any of these items?

Reduce is better than recycle- can you do without any of these?

Refuse is better than recycle- can you buy packaging-free or avoid single-use?
